**Ohio UP Youth
2010 Mission Trip**



Eleven youth and three adult leaders are currently registered to travel to Bay City, Michigan the week of June 20th to do community service for the community. In the coming months, there will be opportunities for the congregation to help support this group financially and spiritually as they prepare for their trip.

There are currently two ways you can help support this trip financially. One of the ways is to continue bringing you aluminum cans to the church. The receptacle is located in the downstairs coat room. The cans will be redeemed for cash at the scrap yard. The other way you can help is to purchase a mile, or more, of the trip. The total amount we need to raise to cover registration fees is \$2977.00. This comes out to approximately \$4.00 per mile. There are envelopes located in the pew pockets labeled with this information. You may use these envelopes or your weekly offering envelope and designate the mission trip under "special offering".

You can support the group spiritually by keeping them in your prayers as they prepare for the trip. In preparing for the trip, not only do tools and supplies need to be gathered, but the group needs to prepare themselves spiritually for what God has in store for them during their week in Bay City. The goal of the mission trip for the youth and adults is to help them grow in their faith as they show God's love by serving others. So please keep this trip in your prayers, and pray that all of those participating will come back to Ohio UP knowing that they have touched the lives of others, and that through that experience they have grown closer to God.

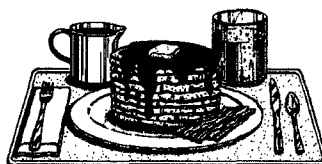
Soup and Pie Luncheon
