From the Pastor

January is a time for setting goals, and making plans for the new year. As we look forward to the months ahead and think about the things that have happened in the past year, we may be filled with hope or with dread. At times like this I'm reminded of the first question and answer from the Heidelberg Catechism.

Q. 1. What is your only comfort, in life and in death?

A. That I belong--body and soul, in life and in death--not to myself but to my faithful Savior, Jesus Christ . . .

I am comforted and inspired by the knowledge that I am participating in an undertaking that is bigger and more lasting than anything I can accomplish on my own. It makes me wonder, though, what is my part? When I sent my children into their Sunday School classes, I knew that they would get a lot more out of Sunday School if they were able to take part in all aspects of the experience. I provided them with a Bible, and I gave them a quarter or two to put in the offering. When they met me after class, I asked them what they had learned. I helped them to understand that the offering that they gave made it so that they and other kids could have materials and a comfortable place to meet.

They didn't have to do anything to be permitted to join the class, but the more they put into Sunday School the more they got out of it. Our life in Christ is a little like that. We don't have to do anything to be loved and cared for by God and experience his blessing. Like my children who only had what I had given them to share in the class, I only have what God has given me. But when we take the gifts that God has given us and share them with others we get to be a partner with God in the sharing of heavenly gifts with the people of earth. May we make our plans and set our goals remembering that we get to participate in what God is doing all around us. Happy New Year.

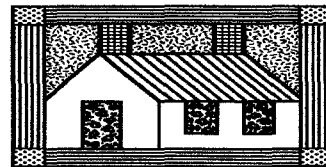

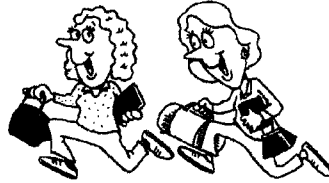
As I close the door
