From the Pastor

New classes, new teachers, and new assignments are in order. I'm not talking about school. I'm talking about our new Church Fellowship Program. I'm talking about a new weekday Bible Study.

As I mentioned last month, for a lot of reasons it seems clear that the FEAST program has run its course. What is emerging in its place is exciting. Please keep up with the news as its coming fast. The New Church Fellowship Program. is guided by the capable hands of Patti Strominger. Church Fellowship will be responsive to the needs of the congregation. It will retain some of the best features of FEAST, but will not be anchored to one particular night or to the youth group or the choir or any program in particular. The emphasis will be on periodic fellowship, service, learning, and even worship opportunities.

We look forward to meals together. Stimulating programs, seasonal emphases, and experiences and opportunities that are not stifled by a rigid schedule. We will be able to have guest speakers. Music, worship and study opportunities in conjunction with a meal or not, on Sunday afternoon or Monday night or another time that suits the congregation best.

In Summary Church Fellowship will no longer be a regularly scheduled meeting. It will become event driven. Youth Group will still meet on Thursday nights. There may still be meals on Thursday night. Choir will continue to practice at their same time.

There will be a new weekday Adult Bible Study. Having the Bible study by itself will multiply the sort of studies that we can undertake since we won't be locked into anyone else's schedule. 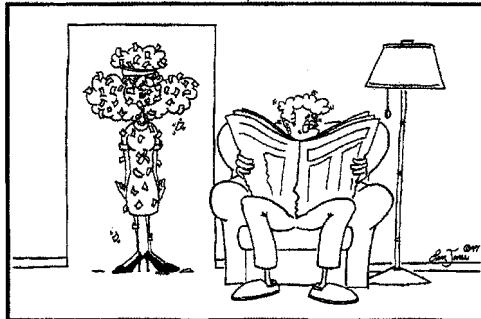
